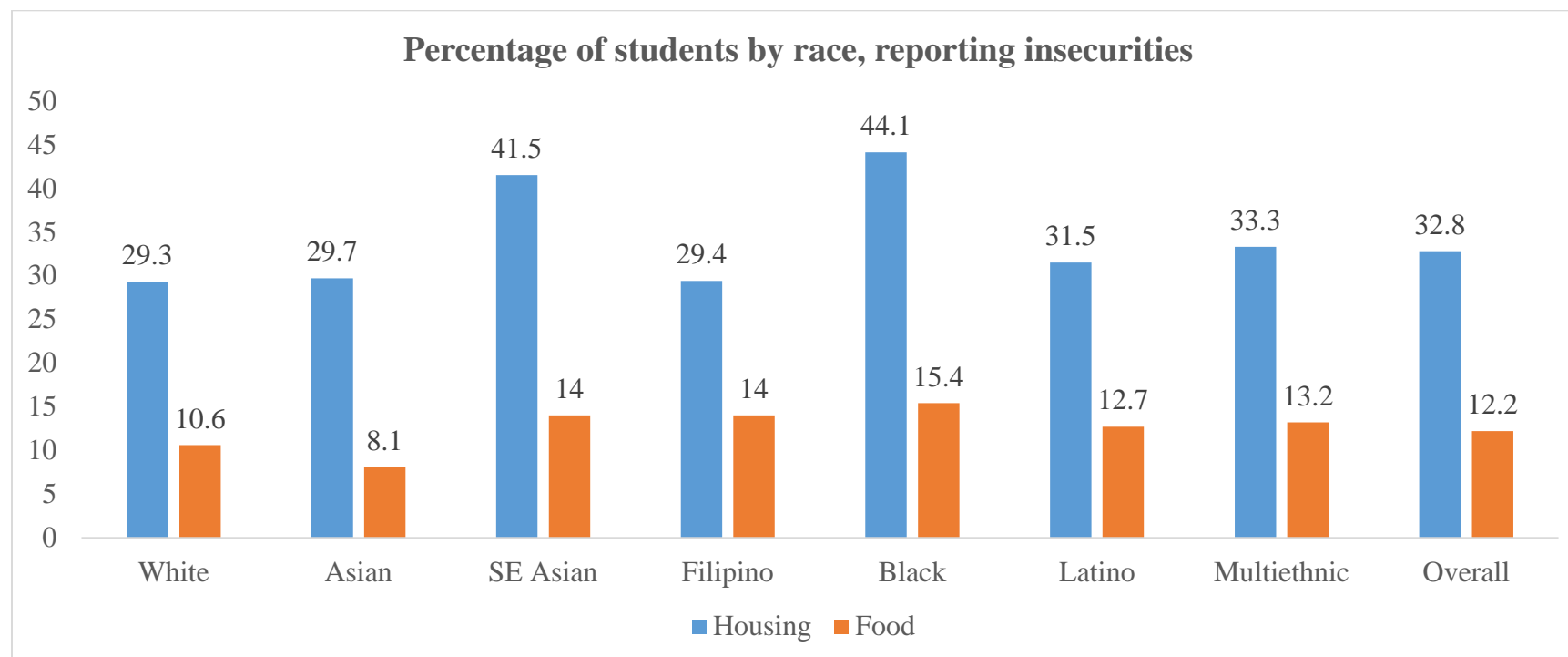


PREVALENCE OF INSECURITIES



Across all racial groups, students reported experiencing housing insecurities (32%) at a higher percentage than food insecurities (12.2%). When disaggregated by race, Black and Southeast Asian students reported experiencing housing and food insecurities at a higher percentage than their student counterparts. In particular, the majority of students who reported experiencing housing insecurities were Black (44.1%) and Southeast Asian (41.5%) students followed by Multiethnic (33.3%) and Latino (31.5%) students. Similarly, a larger percentage of Black students (15.4%) followed by Southeast Asian (14%) and Filipino (14%) students reported experiencing food insecurities.
